Livelihood Protection

Livelihood Protection provides necessary assistance to people who are having difficulties in daily life, assures them the minimum standard of living and helps them become independent.

Households can apply at the Social Welfare Division. If their income is found to be under the minimum limit specified by law, they will receive assistance accordingly for daily living expenses, housing, medical care, etc.

Commissioned Welfare/Child-Welfare Volunteers

Kasama City has a capacity of 151 commissioned welfare volunteers and commissioned child welfare volunteers (including 8 chief commissioned child welfare volunteers).

The city has been divided into three districts and a council has been established to work as a welfare commissioner and child welfare commissioner.

Each committee member has a district in charge and is an unpaid volunteer working to improve welfare as a good consultation partner in the district.

Disaster Relief Money

Relief money and other benefits are provided in instances of death resulting from natural disaster, disability resulting from natural disaster, and other damages due to disaster such as fire and flood.

Regional Comprehensive Support Center “Honobono”

Regional Comprehensive Support Center “Honobono” has been established to provide elderly people with comprehensive and continuous access to necessary services such as health care, medical care and nursing care in areas where they are accustomed to living.

It is a consultation counter for care prevention and general life of elderly people, so please use it if you have any concerns.

Three types of services come together to help you.

At Honobono, workers such as support care specialists, social welfare workers, public health nurses, come together as a team to support the elderly.

The comprehensive support center provides the following services:
